## **The Forum Structure:**

The Forum is held over two days. It enables the Ministry of Health (and its relevant contracted agents) to give up-to-date information about the Health Protection work programme, including policy developments that may impact on Public Health Services' activities or the Ministry's expectations of them. The focus is to communicate on health protection issues important to the Ministry, Public Health Services and other health protection staff. The Forum provides an opportunity for networking, discussion of case studies, policy advice, updates, identification of key issues for Ministry attention, etc.
